BRING ALONG THE WHOLE FAMILY. Children under 18 stay <u>FREE</u> in the same room as their parents (Howard Johnson literature). The hotel has a pool, and other recreation is close by. If there is a good response from families, a separate youth program will be planned to occupy their time, while the rest of us hold our meetings.

All facilities at this hotel are fully handicapped accessible, so any special needs should be well taken care of.

In your mailings, you will note there are two tour packages (on separate days). There are no conflicting tours, so you won't feel you are missing anything. If you don't care to take the scheduled tours, you will be able to "do your own thing" during that time.

The chairpeople have been working very hard and we are assured the program is excellent and everyone should thoroughly enjoy themselves. The musical entertainment is going to be very enjoyable.
